1. **Can the Minister please provide details on the expansion of the Family Violence Safety Action Pilot, including the following information:**
  - a. **By how much will integrated case work capacity be increased?**
  - b. **What has been the exact increase in demand to support the needs of high-risk families?**
  - c. **To date, how many families have been supported through the pilot?**

Minister Berry: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

1.
  - a. The number of case workers during the pilot was 2. This has been increased to 6 as the service transitions from a pilot to a program.
  - b. There were 246 referrals to the service in 2021-22, compared with 129 referrals in 2020-21.
  - c. 260 victim-survivors were provided with case coordination by the pilot (2020-21 and 2021-2022 period).
