In relation to: Family Violence Risk Assessment and Management Framework

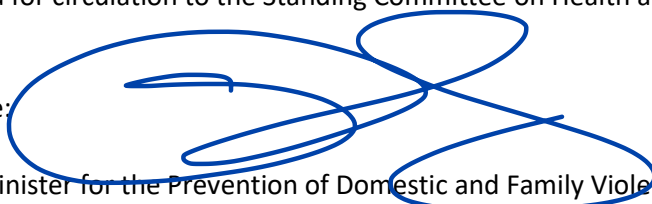
1. The finalised version of the Family Violence Risk Assessment and Management Framework was published in July of this year, and I understand that the ACT Government arranged training on this Framework to specialist domestic and family violence sector organisations in the couple months prior to its publication. Will there be training provided for the application of the Framework in our schools and hospitals as well? If so, when will that occur?
 - a. What further training on the Framework is currently being undertaken, and which other mainstream services will be trained?
 - b. When will the implementation plan for the promotion and embedding of the Framework be completed, and how will the ACT Government promote the Framework to private groups and organisations in the ACT?

Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:--

1. Training on the application of the ACT Domestic and Family Violence Risk Assessment and Management Framework will be available to staff in schools, hospitals and other services, as part of an integrated response to domestic and family violence in the ACT. Prior to training being delivered, the ACT Government is firstly developing a training plan to articulate learning outcomes and provide a training schedule.
 - a & b. The training plan under development will identify training options that target specialist and mainstream services. In developing this plan, the ACT Government will also consider how to promote training offerings to different service sectors. The training plan is scheduled to be delivered in 2023.
