In relation to: Inquiry into minor offences

- 1) Of the current sentenced detainee's at AMC, how many of them have driving a motor vehicle without a licence or driving an unregistered vehicle offences as part of their offending history?
- 2) Of the current detainee's on remand at AMC, how many of them have driving a motor vehicle without a licence or driving an unregistered vehicle offences as part of their offending history?

MICK GENTLEMAN MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

As of 28 June 2023, of the 203 sentenced detainees in the Alexander Maconochie Centre (AMC), 72 (35%) detainees presented with a licence-related offence (includes driving without a licence, driving whilst licence suspended/cancelled etc) or a vehicle registration offence (includes driving an unregistered/suspended vehicle) as part of their offending history.

As of 28 June 2023, of the 178 remanded detainees in the Alexander Maconochie Centre (AMC), 84 (47%) detainees presented with a licence-related offence (includes driving without a licence, driving whilst licence suspended/cancelled etc) or a vehicle registration offence (includes driving an unregistered/suspended vehicle) as part of their offending history.
