In relation to: Major Projects Canberra Designated Projects targets compliance

For Gender and Apprentice targets in Designated Projects what compliance program is undertaken to ensure that contractors are meeting these targets?

Mr Andrew Barr MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

The Light Rail Stage 2A Project includes gender and apprentice targets. Key performance measures for achieving these targets are agreed with contractors, as well as the Technical Advisory and delivery partners, and included in the relevant contracts to ensure the Light Rail Project can measure compliance of outcomes against targets. The Territory monitors progress against these targets monthly through its project governance framework reporting, compliance is then managed in accordance with the project's contract management processes.

The Canberra Hospital Expansion Project's head contractor identified its commitments to achieving social objective targets regarding its trainees and apprentices, and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander (ATSI) employment through its submission of tender. The Territory monitors progress against these targets monthly through its project governance framework reporting, compliance is then managed in accordance with the project's contract management processes.

The Canberra Institute of Technology Woden Campus Project head contractor commitments to achieve employment and social outcomes against Women in Construction and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples participation targets are monitored monthly and reported in accordance with the project governance framework, compliance is then managed in accordance with the project's contract management processes.
