Asked by Mr Cain on 31 July 2023: Mr Steel MLA took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to: Government Procurement Board Public Employee Members

MR CAIN: So minister, are you able to table all correspondence related to the appointment processes that your previous ministers have undertaken for public employee members of this board?

Mr Steel: I will take that on notice.

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

Since the establishment of the Government Procurement Board, there have been more than 20 public employee members appointed through notifiable instruments by previous ministers. Instruments of appointment are available at <https://www.legislation.act.gov.au/a/2001-28> under the "Regulations and Instruments" tab.

I am advised by my Directorate that the retrieval of the information sought relating to these appointment processes is not in an easily retrievable form, and that to collate and assemble all the relevant information would be an unreasonable diversion of resources. I am also advised that large portions of the material would be personal information, and as such, would need to be considered under privacy and other relevant legislation.
