Asked by Mr Jeremy Hanson CSC MLA on 22 November 2023: Professor Lincoln took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to: Undergraduate ATAR requirement

MR HANSON: What is the ATAR for a teacher? What is the requirement?

Ms Lincoln: The undergraduate degree?

MR HANSON: Yes.

Ms Lincoln: Yes, I do not know and we will take that one on notice. Of course, at the postgrad level it is having an undergraduate degree that is the qualification we need.

MR HANSON: But you have got to have one of those.

Ms Lincoln: Yes.

MR HANSON: All right, great.

Professor Michelle Lincoln: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

All courses are published with an indicative selection rank requirement via <https://www.canberra.edu.au/future-students/study-at-uc/find-a-course/view-all-courses>

Generally, the indicative selection rank required for an undergraduate teaching degree is 60 or above, however this is subject to change depending on demand.

The University publishes Admissions Comparison data every year (post August) which covers the raw ATAR and Selection Rank details for the Semester 1 intake of the year, searchable by individual courses.

As an example, for the Bachelor of Secondary Education/Bachelor of Science in 2023, the lowest raw ATAR that received an offer from the University (for Semester 1 intake 2023) was 64.35 and the highest was 98.75.
