THE CHAIR: And have Riverview confirmed that the Corkhill Brothers' property will be included in the joint venture?

Mr Lee: So the joint venture agreement has very specific provisions around the commitment of that land towards the Ginninderry Joint Venture, so the development rights over that New South Wales land are with the joint venture.

THE CHAIR: Earlier this year you said Parkwood would be the first part of the joint venture development to begin in New South Wales. Does this depend on negotiations with the New South Wales government or how are you managing the time constraints associated by saying it is going to be your first one.


Ms Berry: That is right but it is not expected for some time because obviously we are still in negotiations with the New South Wales government to change the border, so those conversations are continuing. I just cannot recall the timeframe that we have that the master plan describes. We will take it on notice.

MINISTER BERRY: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Parkwood land is still intended to be the first developed area within NSW and no, the development of this area is not dependent on the ACT/NSW border move.
