Minister for City and Government Services took on notice the following question(s):

MR MILLIGAN: Thank you, Chair. I would assume this comes under your area, but it is in relation to the call on government to act on back in April 2022 and that was obviously with Christ Steel at that point in time. But it is regarding the Hall storm water infrastructure and laneways. It does not seem that there has been a lot of progress made on that matter. I know there has been a bit of an investigation report done and some community consultation, but that is as much as I know at this point in time, so just wondering if I get a bit of an update on how that is progressing?

Ms Cheyne: Yes. Ms Clement will be very happy to assist.

Ms Clement: Sophie Clement, Executive Branch Manager for Infrastructure Delivery in TCCS, and I have read and understood the privileges statement. Thank you for the question. So we have funding at the moment to progress the design of the stormwater improvements for Hall to address some of the issues there. That work is progressing and we have had consultation over the last six months with the Hall, I think it is the Progress Association, around that. And based on the current information I have, I think we will be completed with that design work by the middle of the year.

MR MILLIGAN: So middle of the year. How much money has been put aside for that design?

Ms Clement: I have to take that on notice. I do not have it on hand, just to be accurate

Ms Tara Cheyne MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The Concept Options Study for the Hall Stormwater upgrades, completed in June 2023, had a cost of \$144,587.90 (excluding GST). The detailed design of the Hall Stormwater upgrades amounted to \$271,727.27 (excluding GST).
