ACCOMPANYING STATEMENT

Background

Section 10 of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* (the Act) provides for the Remuneration Tribunal (the Tribunal) to inquire into and determine the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements to be paid to a person holding a position or appointment mentioned in schedule 1 of the Act, or specified in an instrument given to the Tribunal by the Chief Minister.

On 10 September 2024, the Chief Minister requested the Tribunal to determine the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements for the Chair and Members of the Voluntary Assisted Dying Oversight Board.

On 14 February 2025, the Chief Minister requested the Tribunal to determine the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements for the Chair, Deputy Chair and Members of the Disability Advisory Council.

On 3 March 2025, the Chief Minister requested the Tribunal to determine the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements for the Co-Chairs and Members of the ACT Place Naming Advisory Committee.

On 11 March 2025, the Chief Minister requested the Tribunal to determine the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements for the External Member of the Cultural Facilities Corporation Audit Committee.

Considerations

Voluntary Assisted Dying Oversight Board

The Tribunal noted that the Voluntary Assisted Dying Oversight Board is a statutory advisory body established to monitor applications for voluntary assisted dying and legal compliance in accordance with the *Voluntary Assisted Dying Act 2024* (the Act), which comes into effect on 3 November 2025.

In considering the remuneration of the Chair and Members of the Voluntary Assisted Dying Oversight Board, the Tribunal had regard to the proposed work value of the Chair and Members as well as remuneration of similar positions in the ACT. The Tribunal met with officials from the ACT Health Directorate.

Disability Advisory Council

The Tribunal noted that the Disability Advisory Council is a statutory advisory body established to provide strategic advice to the Minister for Disability on issues affecting people with disability and their families in the ACT; and to provide a link between the Minister for Disability and the local disability community.

In considering the remuneration of the Chair, Deputy Chair and Members of the Disability Advisory Council, the Tribunal had regard to the proposed work value of the Chair, Deputy Chair and Members as well as remuneration of similar positions in the ACT. The Tribunal met with officials from the Community Services Directorate.

ACT Place Naming Advisory Committee

The Tribunal noted that the ACT Place Names Advisory Committee is a non-statutory advisory body established to provide expert advice and recommendations to the Minister for Planning and plays an integral role in representing the community in place naming in accordance with the *Public Place Names Act 1989*.

In considering the remuneration of the Co-Chairs and Members of the ACT Place Names Advisory Committee, the Tribunal had regard to the proposed work value of the Co-Chairs and Members as well as remuneration of similar positions in the ACT. The Tribunal met with the Surveyor General and officials from the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate.

Cultural Facilities Corporation Audit Committee

The Tribunal noted that the Cultural Facilities Corporation (CFC) Audit Committee is a non-statutory committee established by the CFC Board Charter to provide independent assurance and assistance to the Board on the Corporation's financial management, risk, control and compliance framework, and its external accountability responsibilities.

In considering the remuneration of the External Member of the Cultural Facilities Corporation Audit Committee, the Tribunal had regard to the proposed work value of the External Member as well as remuneration of similar positions in the ACT. The Tribunal met with officials from the Cultural Facilities Corporation.

Decision

Voluntary Assisted Dying Oversight Board

The Tribunal determines that the Chair will be remunerated at \$1,300 per diem and Members at \$1,040 per diem.

Disability Advisory Council

The Tribunal determines that the Chair will be remunerated at \$635 per diem, Deputy Chair at \$590 per diem and Members at \$545 per diem.

ACT Place Naming Advisory Committee

The Tribunal determines that the Co-Chairs will be remunerated at \$635 per diem and Members at \$545 per diem.

Cultural Facilities Corporation Audit Committee

The Tribunal determines that the External Member will be remunerated at \$545 per diem.

1 Commencement

- 2.2 The remuneration for the Member of the Voluntary Assisted Dying Oversight Board is \$1,040 per diem.
- 2.3 The remuneration for the Chair of the Disability Advisory Council is \$635 per diem.
- 2.4 The remuneration for the Deputy Chair of the Disability Advisory Council is \$590 per diem.
- 2.5 The remuneration for the Member of the Disability Advisory Council is \$545 per diem.
- 2.6 The remuneration for the Co-Chair of the ACT Place Naming Advisory Committee is \$635 per diem.
- 2.7 The remuneration for the Member of the ACT Place Naming Advisory Committee is \$545 per diem.
- 2.8 The remuneration for the External Member of the Cultural Facilities Corporation Audit Committee is \$545 per diem.

3. Other Conditions

- 3.1 All conditions specified in Determination 15 of 2024 relating to Part-time Public Officeholders, or its replacement, will also apply to the Chair and Members of the Voluntary Assisted Dying Oversight Board, the Chair, Deputy Chair and Members of the Disability Advisory Council, the Co-Chairs and Members of the ACT Place Naming Advisory Committee, and the External Member of the Cultural Facilities Corporation Audit Committee.
