As a resident of Weetangera since 1984 I am much disturbed by the proposal of Woolworths to develop our quiet rather charming Hawker Village shops into a large busy and noisy commercial enterprise.

Hawker and Weetangera are treasured residential suburbs of Belconnen and of Canberra which are very adequately served by the Jamison Plaza in Macquarie, the Kippax Center and Westfield Mall. In my forty years of living in [REDACTED] I have never encountered any neighbour or other person who wanted more or closer shopping facilities: the reverse is true - residents and visitors alike have admired the peace and quiet of this area and wished they lived in an equally attractive place.
