Mr Braddock, Andrew: To ask the Minister for Transport —

Both Apple and Android have express payment options for transit where you don't have to authenticate digital wallet payments for payments on public transportation. This involves configuring transport card readers to signal to digital wallets that such transactions don't need authentication. This could save time from people having to use Face ID or key in their passcode holding up queues at the reader.

Why is this not a feature we have brought on for MyWay+ readers?

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Express payment methods can be enabled for MyWay+ as the feature is supported by the readers.

The feature was not included in the go live functionality with the knowledge that it could be enabled after the go live functionalities had been observed to be consistently available in production.
