The Board:

Superannuation arrangements for Members of the ACT Legislative Assembly are prescribed under the *Legislative Assembly (Members' Superannuation) Act 1991* (the "Act").

The Australian Capital Territory Legislative Assembly Members Superannuation Board (Board) is responsible for the administration of the Act, specifically, the entitlements of those Members of the Legislative Assembly eligible for the defined benefit scheme as set out in Chapter 2 of the Act.

Annual Reporting Requirements:

Section 11A of the Act requires that the Board must, after each 30 June, present to the Legislative Assembly a report of the Board's operations during the financial year ending on that date.

Function of the Board:

The Board is responsible for:

- determining entitlements in accordance with the Act; and
- determining applications for retirement on the grounds of invalidity.

Constitution of the Board:

There are four Members of the Board:

- the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly;
- a government member;
- an opposition member; and
- the Director-General of the administrative unit responsible for the *Financial Management Act 1996* (Director-General, Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development).
 - The Director-General has delegated these functions to the person occupying the position of Under Treasurer.

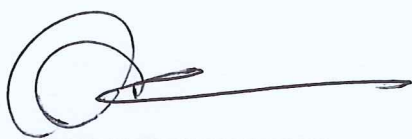
