I refer to the Standing Committee's comments in Scrutiny Report 10 in relation to the Explanatory Statement for the Road Transport (General) Numberplate Fees Determination 2025 (No 4).

This Disallowable Instrument (DI) introduces new fees associated with the Japanese Domestic Market style numberplates that will be offered in the ACT for the first time. The new fees offer the same range, at the same cost, as equivalent European style numberplates already available. As no fees and charges in the Disallowable Instrument are increased, there are no percentage increases.

Should there be a similar scenario in future, a statement will be included in the associated Explanatory Statement to make it explicitly clear that no fee increases are being made.
