MISS NUTTALL: Okay. Got you. Ultimately, how much does the funding for the strengthening supporting and strengthening LGBTIQ+ communities program add up to over the years that it is been in place?

Ms Bogiatzis: So over the years, Ms Connor will look into that. What I can say while she is sourcing that information is that for the 2024-25 financial year for that program the total value of the deed of grant was 224,000. The funded activities included delivery of LGBTIQ+ training for ACT government directorates and community services, peer-led psychosocial support for LGBTIQ+ people and their families. They also operate the CBR pride hub and are focused on organisational capacity building to meet the needs of clients who identify as LGBTIQ+ and also live with disability and operate the service users reference group. Ms Connor may have the information about the total value of the funding over the years.

Ms Connor: Unfortunately not, we will have to take that one on notice. We can confirm that as Ms Bogiatzis said the 24-25 deed total value is \$224,000. But we will have to take on notice any prior to that.

Ms Suzanne Orr MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

From 2019 when the Supporting and Strengthening LGBTIQ+ Communities Program commenced to the end of the current 12-month agreement in September 2026, the total funding of the Program is \$1,376,576 (excl. GST).
