1. What is the timeline for the report from the Youth Assembly to be released?
2. What are the key issues for young people that emerged during the Youth Assembly held earlier this year?

Mr Michael Pettersson MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. The 2025 ACT Youth Assembly Report is scheduled to be tabled in the Legislative Assembly during the 2 to 4 December 2025 sitting period.
2. At the 2025 ACT Youth Assembly, young people focused on three key areas - education, health and housing. In the education domain, young people highlighted the importance of civics education and career guidance, as well as tailored classroom supports. In health, young people highlighted matters relating to access to health care, mental health and sexual health education and services. In housing, young people highlighted matters relating to renting.
