- 1) As the delivery agency for Kingston Arts Precinct following its build, what consultation has iCBR undertaken with the arts organisations to develop their lease and sub-lease conditions?
- 2) Has artist residencies/housing been discussed and has there been any decision from iCBR to manage the lease and maintenance requests for possible residencies?
- 3) If no consultation has occurred between iCBR and the organisations, when will iCBR start consultation?

Michael Pettersson, MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- 1) Infrastructure Canberra (iCBR) has not yet undertaken consultation with arts organisations regarding lease or sub-lease conditions. iCBR is still engaged in understanding arts organisations' requirements to inform the project scope.
- 2) These matters will be considered during later phases of consultation and operational planning.
- 3) iCBR has commenced and will continue to engage with arts organisations through the design, construction and operations at the Kingston Arts Precinct.
