Under the Zero Emissions Government Framework, ACTPS entities have a target of 33% emissions reduction on 2020 levels. How do CMTEDD's reported emissions for 2024-25 compare to this target?

Ms Suzanne Orr: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

In the FY2024-25, the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) reported total emissions of 931 tCO₂e, achieving a 77% reduction when compared to baseline emissions. This reduction is largely due to the transfer of the ACT pools facilities and leisure centres from CMTEDD to ACT Property Group and Infrastructure Canberra (ICBR) in December 2023.

In the five years since the baseline was developed, other fleets and facilities managed under CMTEDD have undergone significant changes. The scope of these changes confounds comparisons with baseline emissions. Re-baselining has been recommended for future reporting years to address this issue.
