New inquiry into Financial Management and Government Procurement Legislative Compliance

The Select Committee on Financial Management and Government Procurement Legislative Compliance has announced it will be undertaking an inquiry examining the ACT Government's compliance with the *Financial Management Act 1996* and the *Government Procurement Act 2001*.

Committee Chair, Ms Fiona Carrick MLA, said 'Transparency of financial management is essential to ensure confidence in the handling of public funds. The Assembly has decided that the ACT Government's compliance with financial management and procurement legislation requires further examination. The Committee welcomes submissions from a variety of stakeholders.'
