Question to the Minister for the Arts and Heritage –

In relation to Government payments for outputs for 2008-09 (vol2, p 160) –

1. Why did the actual amount fall \$470,000 short of budget?
2. What agency outputs or outcomes were affected by the shortfall?

Mr Stanhope: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. The under-spend was primarily in repairs and maintenance of managed arts facilities, deferral of the Arts Canberra Action Statement Review and offset by a one-off grant.
2. Funding was rolled forward for:
 - the restoration of the woolshed at Strathnairn Arts Association;
 - the Manuka Landscaping Project;
 - the Canberra Arts Action Statement; and
 - the Belconnen Arts Centre.
