- o an industry professional assessor from outside the ACT/Capital Region who supplies a reader's report on all applications;
- o an independent industry assessor from within the ACT/Capital Region; and
- o a representative from artsACT.

ScreenACT Assessment Committee members are selected by the CEO of the Canberra Business Council.
