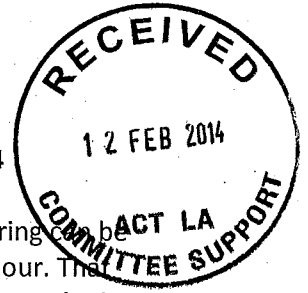


Inquiry into Vulnerable Road Users

Response to question taken on notice at public hearing—Wednesday 12 February 2014



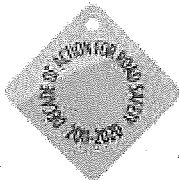
