Referring to my telephone call I wish to raise my concerns about a Game played at the Belconnen Labor Club. Entry to the game "Grocery Grab" is via free tickets, as I understand, as follows:-

- 1/. Member swipes their card on entry to the Club and is given one (1) ticket. Maximum per day is one (1) when swiping card on entry.
- 2). Member is given free tickets randomly whilst playing the poker machines. I am unsure as to the amount however it far exceeds the max of 1 per day of a non gambler.

I realised this when I decided to play Grocery Grab @ November 2014. I had placed my 4 tickets in the box only to see, approx 10-15 minutes before draw commenced, multiple Patrons emerging from the Poker machine area. Some of these patrons were pushing through an extraordinary amount of tickets. I observed one of these Patrons winning Three out of the total draw of fifteen.

My concerns with Grocery Grab are:-

. Discriminates non gamblers as they have far less odds of winning . Seems to actively encourage gambling as "extra free tickets" are earned whilst playing the pokies

I did write to Minister Burch on 28/10/2014 however her advice, received 18/11/2014, was that this game complies with current rules. Ms Burch also advised my concerns would be forwarded to the ACT Gambling & Racing Commission. I telephoned the Commission who confirmed receipt, however I have heard nothing further.

I feel that the game 'Grocery Grab' actively encourages gambling and also discriminates non-gamblers.

I would like my concerns raised with the Committee.

- By playing the gaming machines.

The Promotion and Prizes:
