BEC CODY MLA: To ask the Chief Minister

- 1) What percentage of hours worked in the City Renewal Authority are casual, contractor or other non-permanent staff?
- 2) How many of those people have been engaged in publically funded jobs for longer than six months?
- 3) Of executive position and general staff appointments by the CRA in the last 2 years what proportion were:
  - Women?
  - Attended the ANU or another Group of Eight university?
  - Were educated at a private secondary school?
  - Have a trade qualification?
  - Come from a culturally or linguistically diverse (CALO) household?

ANDREW BARR: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- 1) The City Renewal Authority was established on 1 July 2017. As such, there is no data for the Authority for Financial Year 2016-17.  
The percentage of hours worked in the City Renewal Authority by casual, contractor or other non-permanent staff is not data that is calculated and maintained. The complete and accurate calculation of these hours would require an unreasonable and substantial diversion of Authority resources. I am advised that the Authority's mix of non-permanent, contractor and casual staff as at 30 June 2018 is in the following table.
