- 1) From the 130 Survey respondents
 - a. 27 were satisfied
 - b. 109 were very satisfied
 - c. 2 were neutral
 - d. None was unsatisfied
 - e. None was very unsatisfied
- 2) Participation in the voluntary survey is dependent on event organisers to promote the survey amongst its attendees. It remains paper based despite attempts to provide QR codes to organisers to display, which directs attendees to the electronic version.
