Asked by Mrs Elizabeth Kikkert MLA:

Ref: TCCS Annual Report, TCCS Portfolio, output class 2.1 – Roads and Infrastructure

In relation to: Parking and traffic management on Thynne Street, Bruce in the Australian Capital Territory (ACT)

1. As one means to improve parking and traffic management issues along Thynne Street, the Minister for Transport and City Services related in February 2018 that TCCS would contact the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare (AIHW) to see if there is any opportunity for their private car park to be used by residents out of work hours. What has been the result of this contact?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. TCCS has investigated concerns raised by residents related to parking and traffic on Thynne Street in the vicinity of AIHW. The investigation resulted in proposed parking modifications on Thynne Street to improve the traffic flow, particularly in the morning peak hour, and reduce queues of traffic. It is expected that these improvements will be completed before the end of February 2019.

TCCS contacted the facility management of the AIHW and was advised that there is no plan to make the carpark available out of work hours.
