In relation to:

MISS C BURCH: Okay. All right, no problem. Also I have heard from residents about moving of bus stops and particularly we have heard from people that some work seemed to commence moving bus stops in the few days following the closure of consultation. Can you talk to me about that? How many bus stops have been moved, when did that work commence, when is that work likely to finish?

Ms Fitzharris: Yes, there is quite a bit of work in that.

Ms Meegan Fitzharris MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

As of 15 November 2018 there have been no changes to established bus stops to facilitate the new network design. Any works undertaken have been performed as part of regular business on the public transport network, where stops may be upgraded or changed for a variety of reasons.
