In relation to: Maps of Hot Spots of African Love Grass

Mr Alegria: And also provide an alternative cover of vegetation to prevent further occurrence. So that is where we are looking at combinations of different chemicals with different ways of acting, burning as well, and re-establishing a desirable grass cover that means that the lovegrass is not as likely to come back in.

THE CHAIR: Do we have a map of where all the known lovegrass hotspots are?

Mr Alegria: Yes, we have got maps, yes. They are not—

THE CHAIR: Are you able to share those with the committee?

Mr Alegria: Yes, yes.

THE CHAIR: Okay.

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

African Lovegrass is widespread across the urban areas of the ACT. The attached map shows areas which have been subject to recent and future planned control.
