Asked by Ms Jo Clay MLA: To ask the Attorney-General

In relation to: ACAT E-lodgement

E-lodgement in the ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal is a great idea. When will e-lodgment be available for all matters with ACAT and all courts?

Shane Rattenbury MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

E-lodgement is used in the Courts for civil matters and there are currently 40 documents that can be lodged electronically using ICMS.

E-lodgement is not currently used in the ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal.

ACT Courts and Tribunal has a contract with the Western Australian Attorney-General's Department (the developer for ICMS) to deliver six monthly ICMS releases which remediate defects and make minor system modifications. Minor modifications can include the addition of new document types for E-lodgement.
