MINISTER BERRY: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

Within the Suburban Land Agency (SLA), there is currently no consideration being given to the future use of Coombs Peninsula. The SLA has paused all works on the Coombs Peninsula pending advice from the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate.
