Ref: Output 2.1, Budget paper H, Table 18: 2020-21 TCCS Directorate Infrastructure Program, line item "Building a better city — Active Travel — Footpath and cycleway upgrades", p45.

In relation to: Hawker District Playing Field Upgrades

- 1. Regarding the 2020 election promise to fund the upgrade of lighting, facilities, and parking at the Hawker District Playing Fields, is there funding for this in the budget?
  - a. If so, under what line item is this funding included?
    - i. How much funding will there be for the upgrades?
    - ii. When will the design and construction phase for these upgrades begin?
    - iii. When will the upgrades be completed?
    - iv. Will there be a public consultation phase?
    - v. Are there any specific plans for the upgrades already? If so, what are those upgrades?
  - b. If not, why has the Government not funded this commitment?

Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

1. Funding for this commitment will be progressed within the term of the current Government. Details of scope, timing, design and consultation will be confirmed once a budget allocation has been secured.
