In relation to: Bus services in Macgregor

1. Has a regular bus route that includes going along the entirety of MacFarlane Burnet Avenue been funded in this year's budget or over the forward estimates?

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. No funding has been provided in this year's budget, or over forward estimates to extend along the entirety of MacFarlane Burnet Avenue. The road design of MacFarlane Burnet Avenue, north of the Constance Stone Street intersection, does not meet the width requirements to accommodate a bus route. As a result, the buses servicing route 44 will need to continue to U-turn at the Constance Stone Street roundabout.
