

Inquiry into Giralang Shops



The site of the Giralang Shops needs to be either resumed (purchased back from the developer by the ACT Government), or the developer get on and develop the block.

Personally, I think the land could be put to better use by the ACT Government. For example, a purpose-built respite care facility. There is a shortage of this type of facility in the ACT. The cost of respite can be exorbitant if a person is placed in a facility that is privately run.
