The Committee will hold its third public hearing into the ACT Government's response to the COVID-19 pandemic at 1.30 pm on Thursday, 14 October 2021. A program is below.

The Committee is holding regular public hearings with ACT Government officials and community groups which will be held virtually and live streamed to the public. The hearings can be viewed at the <u>Assembly on Demand</u> website.

Committee Chair, Ms Elizabeth Lee MLA, said "Local businesses, particularly in the hospitality and tourism sectors, have been hit hard by the pandemic. The Committee is keen to hear from industry and business about how the pandemic, lockdown and the ACT government's management has affected them and get feedback on future steps as we emerge out of lockdown."
