In relation to: FTE's for path network audit and maintenance

- 1. When will the current path network audit be complete?
- 2. Does the directorate has adequate FTE's to both complete this in a timely manner, but also ensure ongoing assessment of paths is timely and strategic?

## Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- The Jobs for Canberrans (JFC) program created four new temporary positions for path inspector roles for TCCS. These temporary inspectors are working closely with the existing Roads ACT inspectors to undertake condition audits and defect assessments of the full path network across Canberra. The additional four staff aim to proactively assess the entire ACT's path network by the end of the 2021 calendar year.
