Mr James Milligan MLA: To ask the Minister for Police and Emergency Services, Mr Mick Gentleman MLA

- 1. There is funding provided for a master plan for the ESA critical infrastructure requirements over 2 years, to the value of \$1.658 million.
 - a. What exactly will be included in the development of this plan?
 - b. Will the plan look at the accommodation and staffing needs of the ESA services?
 - c. Who is to be involved in the development of the plan? Will there be consultants employed to undertake the review?
 - d. Can you provide the contact details for these consultants?
 - e. How much of the funding will be paid to the consultants?
 - f. What are the targeted strategic indicators for this funding?
 - g. When can the ESA and Canberran community expect the plan to be released?
