

Legislative assembly Chronology of events – Ben Palmer

Friday 12 Aug 2022 approx. 12:30 – Ben Palmer discussion with Meaghan O'Connor regarding WPV for Legislative assembly, following assignment of the case.

Friday 12 Aug 2022 (approx. 18:00-18:11 – Ben Palmer aware of Prohibition notice verbally issued by Meaghan O'Connor, followed by written Prohibition Notice approved by Robert Alford.

Monday 15 Aug 2022 (approx. 08:30) – Meeting with Commissioner, Brooke Grey, Ben Palmer and Meaghan O'Connor regarding Fridays Prohibition Notice wording, issue raised following a concern sent through to commissioner regarding notice clarity (all activity or in person activity).

Monday 15 Aug 2022 (approx. 09:35) – WPV at Legislative assembly (with , Meaghan O'Connor and Nicole Calvert) to assess Prohibition compliance and clarify any potential issues relating to wording. During WPV, clarification was re-stated on the Prohibition Notice, with re-issue to reflect the clarifying point.

Monday 15 Aug 2022 (approx. 09:38) – txt from Brook Grey to Ben Palmer (needing to speak about Notice re-wording on return to office from WPV).

Monday 15 Aug 2022 (approx. 10:40) – Meeting with Robert Alford, Brooke Grey, Meaghan O'Connor, Ben Palmer and Nicole Calvert. Discussed WPV outcome. Confirmed wording from legal advice that had been sought, provided by Brooke Grey.

Monday 15 Aug 2022 (approx. 1:31-39 pm) – Written Prohibition submitted, reviewed, and approved.

Wednesday 17 Aug 2022 (approx. 3pm) – Teams meeting with Brooke Grey, Robert Alford, Ben Palmer and Meaghan O'Connor, Re: follow up on Prohibition notice progress following day, following concerns of progression of controls. Robert Alford to organise meeting with appropriate PCBU member and advise Ben Palmer and Meaghan O'Connor.

Thursday 18 Aug 2022 – (approx. 5:33pm), Missed call and TXT from Brooke Grey to Ben Palmer, disregards tomorrow's compliance follow up visit – awaiting more information.
