How many of those escalations get resolved through mediation vs go to ACAT etc?

Minister Vassarotti: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: -

Below is data for the 2021/22 Financial Year where a breach of the *Residential Tenancies Act 1997* occurred and resulted in a notice being issued to the tenant by Housing ACT, plus where matters progressed to the ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal.

Action	2021/22
Notice to Remedy issued	916
Notice to Vacate issued	155
Matter progressed to the ACAT	173*

<sup>\*</sup>Note: 113 matters progressed to ACAT were for access orders to conduct a routine inspection.
