 Besides the annual progress statements, what additional reporting and measurement of the actions listed in the Age-Friendly City Plan is conducted?

Minister Davidson: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: -

In addition to the annual progress statements made in the Assembly, directorates provide informal mid-year reporting which is used to track progress and review timelines against actions.

Executive Sponsors of the Age-Friendly City Plan (the Plan) are drawn from participating directorates to provide the Executive-level stewardship for the cross-government implementation of the Plan. Executive Sponsors come together biannually to discuss and champion the progression of actions under the Plan. These meetings provide opportunity for collaboration on joint actions and updates regarding actions under the Plan.

Annual progress reports on actions identified in the Plan are published on the Community Services Directorate's (CSD) website.

High level reporting on progress of the Plan is also presented in the CSD Annual Report.

The Ministerial Advisory Council on Ageing (MACA) also provides advocacy and advice on the Plan's progress and receives updates in relation to actions which align with the MACA workplan.
