MR JAMES MILLIGAN MLA: To ask the Minister for Transport and City Services

Ref: Portfolio area, Budget Outlook pg 190. Output Class 2.1. Roads and Infrastructure - City Services

Hearing Date: 18 July 2023

In relation to: Raised Pedestrian Crossing for Gold Creek School

1. Page 190 of the budget outlook announces raised pedestrian crossings for various locations, including near Gold Creek School. This crossing falls within a 29.5m investment over three years, yet only 6.5m will be spent this financial year. Is this Crossing likely to be completed this year?
 - a. Is the budget referring to Gold Creek High School or Gold Creek Primary?
 - b. If not completed this year, when we the public expect this crossing to be completed?
 - c. How much will the raising of one crossing actually cost?

CHRIS STEEL MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

1. The raised pedestrian crossing is planned to be delivered this financial year.
 - a. The crossing will be provided on Kelleway Avenue near Gold Creek High School.
 - b. The crossing is planned to be delivered this financial year.
 - c. The cost of the specific crossing will not be able to be confirmed until the work has been tendered and completed.
