In relation to: Molonglo Valley Station details

With regards to the joint Fire & Ambulance station in the Molonglo Valley:

- (1) What is the total funding for this initiative?
- (2) How many Firefighters are intended to be stationed there per shift?
- (3) What is the intended completion date?
- (4) What fire and rescue appliances are included in the project cost?
- (5) Does the project cost include provision for Compressed Air Foam (CAFS) appliances, and how many and what specification? (medium or large? Single cab or dual cab?)

MICK GENTLEMAN MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

- (1) Capital funding of \$65.951m to construct a new joint Ambulance and Fire & Rescue Station (including Major Project Canberra fees).
- (2) Funding has been provisioned for 24 firefighters in total to cover all shifts once the station is operational.
- (3) The Station will be operational in 2025-26.
- (4) One frontline fire pumper, and one specialised appliance for the urban interface.
- (5) Yes. One large dual cab.
