Asked by Mr Cain on 31 July 2023: Mr Steel MLA took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to: Government Procurement Board Renewal

MR CAIN: You would certainly get it from the private sector. But I did have a particular question about Mr Hall. So when did he actually leave the board?

Mr Mirzabegian: I would have to take that on notice.

MR CAIN: Thank you. And was his membership to the board renewed in 2021? I guess that is a yes. Is that automatically done or is that through a—

Mr Steel: There would be a process around that I believe. We confirm that on notice, yes.

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: —

Mr Hall resigned from the Board on 6 June 2023, effective 16 June 2023.

In 2021, the Executive Group Manager of Procurement ACT recommended the reappointment of Mr Hall to the Special Minister of State. Following his approval to proceed, a formal process was undertaken, resulting in a government decision to reappoint Mr Hall through the required legislative instrument.
