Inquiry into Annual and Financial Reports 2022-2023 **ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE**

Asked by Ms Elizabeth Kikkert on 22 November 2023: Ms Rebecca Minty took on notice the following question:

In relation to:

MRS KIKKERT: More variety and more time spending on it. When was the last time you visited AMC?

Ms Minty: I would have to take that on notice, to be honest. My team were out there—

Mr Costello: Yes, we were out there—yes, we will take that on notice but it probably would have been approximately six weeks ago.

MRS KIKKERT: Six weeks ago.


Mr Costello: Yes.

Inspector of Correctional Services: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

Members of staff from the Inspector of Correctional Services were last onsite at the Alexander Maconochie Centre on 26 September 2023.

The Inspector last attended AMC on 28 July 2023 as part of National Preventive Mechanism (NPM) visit: Transition to Smokefree. Although the Inspector and staff visit the AMC from time to time when reviews are not on foot, subsequent to completing that visit there were no current thematic or whole of centre reviews relating to AMC during this period. As a part time statutory office holder, the Inspector's focus in the subsequent period was on finalising a Critical Incident review and a thematic review of Bimberi Youth Justice Centre due for tabling in November 2023.
