**MR PARTON:** Good answer. Thank you. Property condition complaints have increased. This looks like a take-on-notice thing, but I am just going to ask. What are the top three property condition complaints received? Is anyone going to wade in or will we—

**Ms Berry:** We might have to take that one on notice, Mr Parton.

Ms Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

In 2022-23, the top 3 property condition complaints received by Housing ACT were:

- 246 complaints about property surrounds which includes unkept gardens, trees, rubbish and cars,
- 44 complaints about cars being parked inappropriately, and
- 22 complaints for unapproved structures.
