Asked by Elizabeth Kikkert MLA on 23 November 2023: Andrew Barr MLA took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to: Revenue resulting from payroll tax

THE CHAIR: But, Chief Minister, could you please just answer the question. How much revenue the ACT government expects to collect as a result of this payroll tax to GPs?

Mr Barr: Well, there already is revenue collected from GPs payroll tax. I am not in a position to disclose the amount each individual tax payer pays. What I can do is take the question on notice and provide what information we can. We do not breakdown the data to the point that we may be able to answer the question and the detail, I suspect, that you are seeking but we will endeavour to provide the answer that we can.

Andrew Barr MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

The Government has not adjusted payroll tax revenue estimates as a result of the taxation amnesty provided on payments to contracted GPs.
