
As part of a \$7 million project to upgrade all five ACT netball facilities, the government has opened a new one in Jacka. The four fenced courts, located at 10 Dospot Way, will eventually be joined by eight more, LED lighting (for night play) and a pavilion in Jacka.

(1) What are the development timeframes for the promised 8 new courts, the lighting and the pavilion?

YVETTE BERRY MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Delivery of the four community netball courts at Jacka was not part of the ACT Government's \$7.5 million commitment to upgrade Canberra's five district netball facilities. The four community courts, associated carparking, fencing and conduits for floodlighting were delivered by the Suburban Land Agency (SLA) as part of Jacka – Stage 1B works. Floodlighting design for the existing four courts is currently underway with installation expected to take place in late 2025. Delivery of the remaining courts (with floodlighting) and the pavilion is subject to future budget consideration.
