ANDREW BARR MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Between 2019 and 2024, five projects were funded which were led by LGBTIQ+ Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. This includes:

- two projects funded under the Connection Fund;
- one project funded under the Partnership and Capacity Building Stream; and
- two LGBTIQ+ Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander leaders funded under the LGBTIQ+ Leadership stream.
