THE CHAIR: I am happy to be correct on that, Minister, you have been doing it longer than me. I will get you to take these on notice so I can hand over to others, but I will do it live to make sure you can take it. You mentioned the pipeline of public housing, are you able to provide us with some information about how many public homes are in that pipeline?

Ms Berry: Absolutely. Yes.

THE CHAIR: Great. Maybe for the next 12 months is that a—

Ms Berry: I will probably give you to the end of this program to—

THE CHAIR: That would be great. Yes, thank you.

Ms Berry: From when the current growth and renewal program finishes '26/'27, we can definitely provide you with that information.

THE CHAIR: That would be great. Also on notice, can you tell me what—

Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The 2025-26 Financial Year public housing dwelling pipeline is forecast to deliver 120 Constructions and 50 Acquisitions. 21 of the 120 forecasted dwellings have been delivered through construction to September 2025.

A further 113 dwellings via the Construction pipeline are to be delivered in 2026-27 for the Growing and Renewing Public Housing program.

The program will also see an additional 128 dwellings acquired in 2026-27, providing a total of 411 dwellings to be delivered by June 2027.
