The Gowrie Cricket Nets project listed on the City Services website is undergoing planning and design. I just wanted to confirm, because there are two ovals at Gowrie and both have cricket nets, which of the nets is the project relating to and what is the timeline? Presumably, the project will not be ready this summer, but summer '26-27? Is that feasible?|

**Ms Yvette Berry:** The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The Gowrie Cricket Nets project relates to the cricket nets located at the southern most oval (Gowrie 117 cricket nets). The works are currently in the tender process and are scheduled for completion by mid 2026, which means they will be ready for the 2026/2027 season. The new cricket nets will not be available for this summer's cricket season.
