Given the winding up of CIT Solutions, when will senior secondary language offerings in the ACT public education system be finalised for Year 11 students commencing in 2026?

Ms Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Language education offerings are a school-based decision and have been finalised for 2026. Advice on options for year 11 students commencing in 2026 is communicated to students and families at time of enrolment. Schools were advised on 4 December 2025 on arrangements for 2026.

Students wishing to study a language in year 11 will be required to access language courses via existing school enrolment options or the BSSS specialist education provider, currently for Chinese only.

Students enrolled at one ACT public college who wish to study a language offered by another ACT public college may be able to arrange access to that course. Students and their parents or carers can discuss these options with their college directly.
