Further Details of the Incident	P01 was found crying at the fence, her feet were stuck under the bottom railing between that and the concrete. She was upset with no visible injury, started with being able to walk but then stopped weight bearing. Mum was called to take her to a medical profession. She attended the walk in clinic then hospital which confirmed a leg fracture needing a cast. Mum emailed to explain the results. P01 (director) called at 8.35 2.8.23 to discuss how P01s and what supports could happen. She mentioned that the doctor said she must have fallen whilst her foot stuck under the fence or that she tried to remove it and twisted it causing the break. Educators only saw her standing at fence holding on with feet stuck, as P01 went to lift her for cuddle P01 moved her feet out.								
Details of Action Taken (e.g. First Aid)	Checked her legs and feet by multiple educators. Gave icepack when still upset but no visible injury. then not weight bearing on left leg - asked management for help and then called mum for medical profession help.
